All students must meet the required age and be fully potty trained to attend.

PARENTS: In order to qualify for UPK, please visit <u>upk.colorado.gov</u> to create an account. Select ONLY Dayspring Christian Academy under preferred school.

**Non-refundable registration fees:** \$150 per student. This fee is paid upon enrollment and secures your student's spot for the upcoming school year. (\$450 family max)

**Monthly payments:** All tuition payments are due monthly. There are no additional fees if you set up automatic payments through your bank. If you pay with a debit or credit card *you will be charged an additional 2.95% service fee* for the amount billed.

Payment options: Payment in full, payment per semester, or monthly (10 month plan)

**Other expenses:** Families are responsible for additional expenses charged to their FACTS account such as lunches and field trips.

**Future Re-enrollment:** When it is time to re-enroll, current Pre-K 3, Pre-K 4, and Pre-K 5 families must <u>manually</u> re-enroll their students online through the Renweb Family Portal under the Apply/Enroll tab on the left. Availability is on a first come, first serve basis. Families will be charged the \$150 non-refundable registration fee to guarantee your student's enrollment for the following school year.

**Student withdrawal policy:** If a student will not return to DCA the following school year, parents must submit a written statement of withdrawal **before February 1<sup>st</sup>**. Withdrawals occurring <u>during the school year</u> require a **30 day written notice**. Parents are liable for tuition in full for the month a student withdraws. In accordance with DCA's *Continuous Enrollment Program*, if a withdrawal occurs after February 1<sup>st</sup>, parents are responsible for the following <u>for each student</u> withdrawn: annual enrollment fee, annual student fee, and first three months of tuition (Aug, Sept, Oct). All withdrawals require a meeting with your student's principal.
