Non-refundable registration fees: \$150 per student. This fee is paid upon enrollment and holds your student’s spot for the upcoming school year. (\$450 family max)

Monthly payments: All tuition payments are due monthly. There are no additional fees if you set up automatic payments through your bank. If you pay with a debit or credit card *you will be charged an additional 2.95% service fee* for the amount billed.

Payment options: Payment in full, per semester, or monthly (12 month plan or 10 month plan).

Other expenses: Families are responsible for additional expenses charged to their FACTS account, such as lunches, field trips, yearbooks, Chromebooks, extracurricular fees, and before school/after school/Friday care.

Future re-enrollment: Current K – 11th grade students will be automatically re-enrolled with our *Continuous Enrollment Program*. Families will still need to verify their payment plan with FACTS. The non-refundable \$150 registration fee will be charged to families’ FACTS accounts in February.

Student withdrawal policy: If a student will not return to DCA the following school year, parents must submit a written statement of withdrawal **before February 1st**. Withdrawals occurring during the school year require a **30 day written notice**. Parents are liable for tuition in full for the month a student withdraws. In accordance with DCA’s *Continuous Enrollment Program*, if a withdrawal occurs after February 1st, parents are responsible for the following for each student withdrawn: annual enrollment fee, annual student fee, and first three months of tuition (Aug, Sept, Oct). All withdrawals require a meeting with your student’s principal.
