All students must meet the age requirement and be fully potty trained to attend.

PARENTS: For the UPK benefit, please visit upk.colorado.gov to create an account. Select Dayspring Christian Academy as your preferred school. Students must be 4 years old by October 1st to qualify.

When registering please select the following hours that correspond with the class chosen for your child:

- 3 half days – choose 10 hours in UPK**
- 3 full days – choose 27 hours in UPK**
- 4 half days – choose 12 hours in UPK**
- 4 full days – choose 30 – 40 hours in UPK**
- Full week/full day – choose 30 – 40 hours in UPK**

Families will be set up on an automatic 10-month payment plan. (July – January and March – May) February we will not collect tuition because families with students in K – 11th grade will pay re-enrollment fees that month for the upcoming school year. Additional payment plan options are available.

NON-REFUNDABLE FEES

All enrollment, re-enrollment, and student fees are non-refundable. The \$150 re-enrollment fee secures your student's placement in the upcoming school year. (\$450 family max) This fee is paid at the time of enrollment and re-enrollment for all Pre-K 3 – Pre-K 5 students.

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

DCA utilizes FACTS Tuition Management to facilitate payment plans for families. We require all tuition payment plans to be established on automatic draft. Families may choose to use a checking or savings account, or, for an additional processing fee, a credit card. Payment frequency options include:

1. Full payment: Due by August 1st for the upcoming school year
2. Semester payments: Due by August 31st and January 31st
3. Monthly or bi-monthly payments: Due on day of choice (July – January and March – May)
4. Additional payment plans can be set up through DCA's business office

Please note that February tuition payments are not collected, as families with students in K – 11th grade will be responsible for re-enrollment fees for the upcoming school year. Withdrawal after July 1st renders all paid tuition non-refundable, and families remain accountable for further payments as outlined in DCA's Withdrawal Policy.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Families are responsible for additional expenses charged to their account such as lunches and field trips.

RE-ENROLLMENT

During re-enrollment, **current Pre-K 3, Pre-K 4, and Pre-K 5 families** must *manually* re-enroll their students online through the Renweb Family Portal under the Apply/Enroll tab on the left. Availability is on a first come, first serve basis. Families will be charged the \$150 non-refundable re-enrollment fee in February.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

If a student currently K – 11th grade will not return to DCA the following school year, parents must submit a written statement of withdrawal **before February 1st** to avoid paying the re-enrollment fee. Any Pre-K 3 – 12th grade withdrawal occurring during the school year requires a **meeting with the principal**. Parents are liable for tuition in full for the month a student withdraws. In accordance with DCA's Continuous Enrollment Program, if a withdrawal occurs after February 1st, parents are responsible for each student's re-enrollment fee and student fee.
